Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why should I bother with an Umbrella Policy?

A: An Umbrella Policy extends coverage over your current personal or commercial policies to increase your liability limits and can provide broader coverage than the stand alone policies, just like an umbrella better protects you from the rain, even if you are wearing a raincoat and boots. Auto and home policies do not offer the high limits of liability often necessary when a tragic event occurs, such as a car accident with serious or fatal injuries. Your future income or your savings can be attached to settle claims that exceed your insurance liability limits. Umbrella policies are relatively inexpensive, often \$100 to \$200. Flooded with Advice

We seem to be having more rain than snow so far this winter, but melting snow is not the only form of spring flooding. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) believes that flooding is the most common natural disaster. The potential for catastrophic losses is outstanding.

Flooding is excluded by homeowners and dwelling policies. The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), administered by FEMA, provides subsidi-



dized rates making flood insurance more readily available to inhabitants in participating communities. FEMA acknowledges that 25-30% of flood claims paid through this program involve property in low- to moderate-flood risk areas and **encourages all home and business owners to investigate flood coverage.**

There is typically a 30 day waiting period once the application is completed and the downpayment made. Certain restriction may apply. Don't wait until you are wading around your basement to find out more! Call us today!

Electronic Funds Transfer

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) makes bill paying easier and can save you money. Most companies are now offering EFT payment plans and some do not charge a billing fee. Please remember that these EFT agreements are between you, your financial institution and the insurance company; **changes need to**

be made in writing directly to the INSURANCE COMPANY and well in advance. New privacy laws mean WE, the Allen/Freeman/McDonnell Agency, CAN NOT guarantee that EFT will be stopped or changed to a different bank account number. Keep all paperwork and contact your company directly to keep your bill paying continuous and your policy in force!
